A Precision shooting competition will also be included at the coming International Australian Open Triple.

The Precision shooting qualification will be held at 10 am on **Friday 18 April 2013**

Qualification rules and regulations for the shooting competition will be provided shortly to all State Leagues.

The precision shooting competition will be played in each category – Men, women, Junior

The International Australian Open Triple will be open to overseas teams

The tournament will be played as

- **Open men** (men only including junior teams)
 - Junior (mixed gender teams authorised as per FIPJP regulations)
- **Open Women**

 - o 9.30 am women round of poules (Top 8 or 16) in function of number of entries
 - o Loser in poules to play Complementaire ¼ final or semi and Final for Men and women
 - o Teams qualified in poules men and women to play ¼ final or semi and final
 - o Teams non qualified to play in a consolante 4 rounds Swiss system No Finals – Ranking only
