Two junior members of the Gawler Pétanque Club have been selected as part of the junior national Australian team which will compete in these world championships.

They are Luke Randall and Cameron Paul. The other two team members are from Western Australia and New South Wales.

The pétanque world governing body, which is an affiliation of 59 member countries, has announced it will be holding the world junior championship in Montauban, France, for

under 18-year-olds, from August 29 to September 1.

Luke recently represented Australia as a member of the Australian junior national team that defeated the New Zealand juniors in Lake Macquarie, New South Wales.

Both teenagers were members of the South Australian junior team in the Interstate Pétanque Championships held in Sydney last November.
