# The Interstate Challenge Championships 2010

All ages and over 60 Championships

**13-14 November 2010**

The Interstate Challenge Championships 2010 will be held under the auspices of the Pétanque Federation Australia at Eastlakes Sports Club, Florence St, Eastlakes, NSW on 13-14 November 2010

The competition is opened to 2 (two) teams per State, (1) all ages team and (1) over 60 team.

### Entry Fees

A flat fee of \$100.= per team must be sent to the PFA Secretary, prior to the scheduled date of the event.

### Other fees

**NSW**= \$30.= per player, coaches and officials to cover breakfast, lunch on the days of the competition  
Accommodation cost will be at the players, coaches and officials expense.

**Other States**= \$50.= per player, coaches and officials, to subsidize the cost for the catering, transport and accommodation

*These funds must be made available by either money order or cheques payable to PFA and forwarded to the above address by the 23 October 2010.*

A team is made up of 8 players (5 men and 3 women) ,1 coach and 1 official

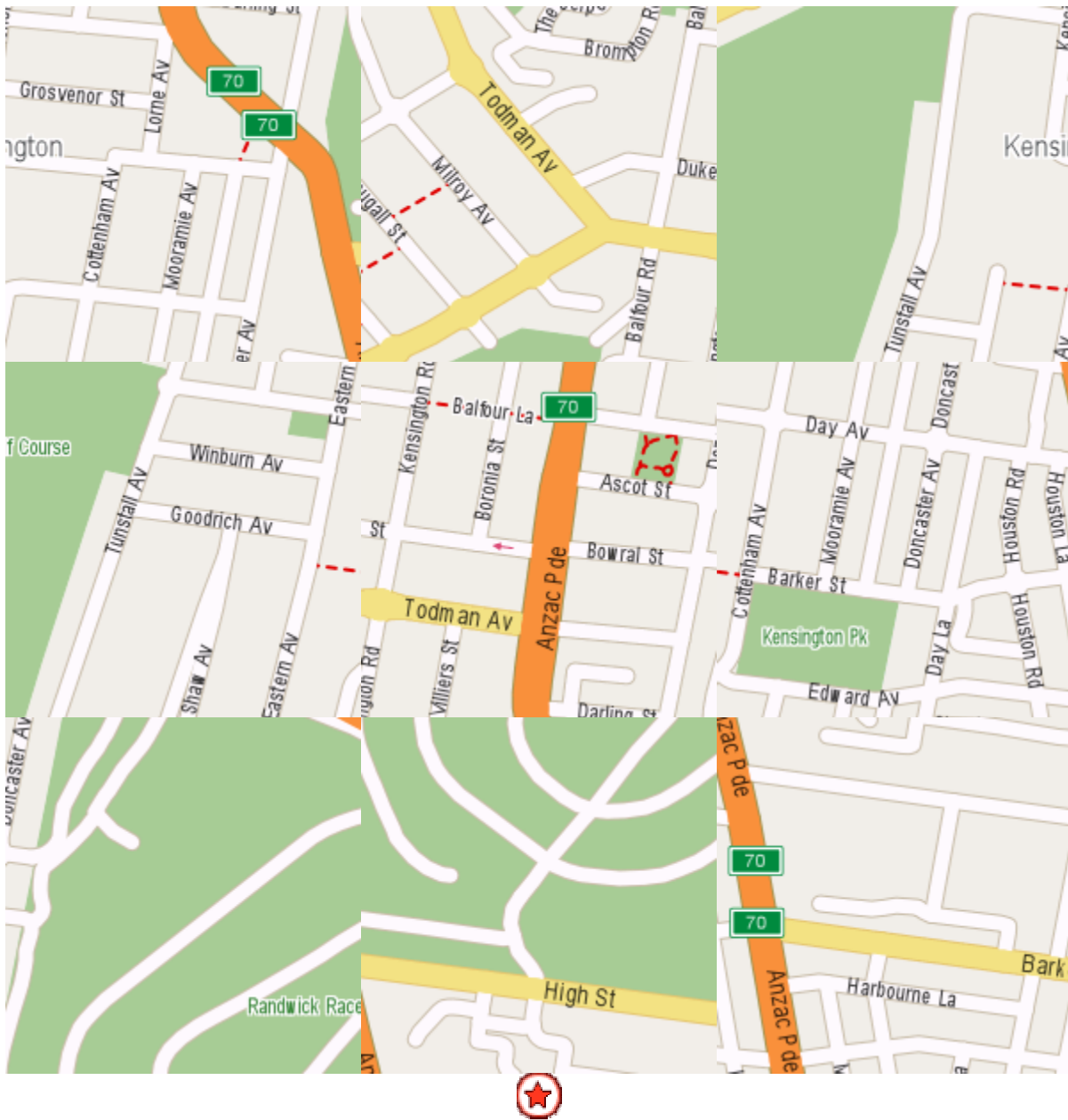

## Programme

## Uniforms

All players shall wear their State colours polo shirts. Players should also wear same coloured pants. Approved footwear as per footwear policy will only be accepted.

**All coaches** on official duties must be Pétanque Federation accredited and licensed. Their uniforms should only bear the Federation Logo.

## Rules

All players and officials must hold a current PFA players license Delegates must ensure that all licenses are in order i.e. photos, stamped signed etc.

The team delegate will collect licenses from their players and present them to the Umpire in charge of the competition.

Licenses will be kept by the organizers and will be returned to the delegate at the end of Sunday's play.

## Umpires

Pétanque Federation Australia rules will apply and be supervised by the nominated National Umpire. The National Umpire will be nominated by the National Director of Umpiring.

## Licenses:

All players, coaches and officials taking part in this competition must hold a current Pétanque Federation Australia License. It will be the responsibility of the team's delegate to present their team's licenses to the umpire in charge of the competition for verification before the event. The licenses will be kept by the Umpire in charge of the competition, and returned to the delegate at the end of the competition.

Delegates should ensure that all licenses are in order (Photos, stamped, duly signed etc)

## Coaches

All coaches involved in the competition must be PFA accredited and licensed.

## The Competition

There will be 6 teams in the all ages (Seniors) and 6 teams in the over 60 categories ( i. e if all States front 2 teams each) so each State will play a full round against each other.

It is expected that 3 to 4 rounds will be played each day of the competition.

## Draw

The draw will be carried out on Friday evening and will not be changed during the competition.

Before each round, a designated team official from each team will complete a team sheet ( provided) nominating their teams.

### **1<sup>st</sup> set**

1. Men's triples and Women's triples teams
2. Men's doubles team

### **2<sup>nd</sup> set**

1. 2 mixed triples teams ( 1 women per team ( minimum)
2. 1 mixed doubles

### **Championships Format**

Each round will consist of three sets of games i.e.

1. Men's triples, women's triples and, 1 men's doubles
2. 2 mixed triples(1 woman minimum per triple) and, 1 mixed doubles

### **Scoring**

Win	3 points
Draw	1 point
Lose	0 point

(At the end of the competition, a count back on the number of games will decide the winner, If the result is still a draw, a count back of points will decide the winner)

### **Prizes.**

#### **(For both the under and over 60 teams)**

Winning team will be declared the Interstate Challenge Champions 2010, their names engraved on the Perpetual Trophy + a memento to remind them of their win per player.

The members of that team will also be selected to representing Australia at the next year's Trans Tasman in Australia.

The runner-up team will be awarded engraved medals for their efforts

**Please note:** At the time we are writing this paper, the team's make up for the Trans Tasman 2011 is still under discussion between both countries (could be 8 or 12 per team), PFA will let you know as soon as we get a final decision
