4. Treasurer's Report:

The Treasurer reported that the bank balance as of 30 June was \$3452.70 with \$304.80 in uncleared cheques. No vote was taken as these figures had been examined at the AGM a few minutes earlier

SAPL will use electronic banking from now on. It was confirmed that payments could be authorised by any two of Adrian Clements, Phil O'Reilly and Stan Wilson.

6. Umpire Report.

Ray Beaumont stated that the report had been sent to the Secretary who confirmed receipt

7. Coaches Report

Adrian Clements spoke about the Interstate Challenge in November of this year saying he was unsure of the team makeup. Dave Ward clarified that Under 60 and Over 60 would be 5 men and 3 ladies. Juniors would be 4 under 18.

Adrian said that he would start Skills training for the State Squad on Saturday afternoons at Propect Pétanque Club. Dates would be 20 and 27 July and August 3 and 10. The training would be open to all licenced players. Team selection would take place at the end of September regular participation in the skills training would be taken into account when making the selection.

The Coach announced that two Juniors from the Gawler Club had been selected to play for Australia in the Junior World Championships to be held at Montauban in France in August 2013. He congratulated the two noting that the team consisted of 4 players one from NSW one from WA and two local players.

Glenis Head the Gawler Pétanque Club President announced that the club was organizing some fund raising activities to help the boys towards their expenses. It was clarified that PFA did not pay any expenses at all they just provide a shirt and cap.

The first fund raiser is a Night at the Dogs on Thursday 25 July when there will be an entrance fee for the races and dinner some of which is paid back to the club also there is a possibility to Sponsor a race for \$300 all of which will go to the club if 100 people attend.

The League committee considered that it may sponsor a race. Gawler agreed to send more details.

The second event is a "Come and Try" Pétanque Tournament to be held at Prospect on the 4 August details will be announced later. The will be a raffle at both events and it was hoped that those who could not attend could perhaps donate towards the raffle.

7. Tournament Directors Report

Round 6 provided an exciting end to the season with 3 Clubs within 3 points of winning. Adelaide club had prevailed winning the 1st Division shield.

Over the season 110 people had participated with an average of 19.3 teams.

There were 24 teams registered for Round 1 in 2012

Ray Beaumont said that there were people in his club that would not play if there was no second division. The TD pointed out that unless a minimum of 21 teams registered it was difficult to organize a meaningful second division.

After discussion around playing doubles instead of triples and also encouraging more players to participate it was decided to leave the competition as it is.

a. Deb Rodda reminded the committee that items previously in the State Uniform are no longer available. Adrian said that his daughter is involved in another sport and their State uniforms have been much admired. He agreed to get a sample for the committee to see and to price up.
