1. Apologies:

4. Treasurer's Report:

The Treasurer tabled a report showing account transactions and that the Bank balance as of 10 November 2016 was \$4928.64, \$1210.71of which is allocated to the Junior Fund. The Treasurer proposed that his report be accepted. Tina Stockley seconded the proposal and it was passed.

5. Umpire's Report.

Peter Beaumont reported that the Round 2 Umpires report was under preparation.

Ray Beaumont reported that PPC used timed games on Sunday 6th and it worked well.

The President thanked Ray for explaining the new International Rules to the players on the evening of 2 November. Ray commented that the new rules have not been published as there is a dispute about some of the content within PFA.

6. Coach's Report

The coach reported that only a few Victorian players had completed the proposed skills test and no one from WA had done them. He reported that, after consultation with Tim Whelan, he had decided that the SA players would not be asked to complete the tests. Trans Tasman selection would be based on players performance in Interclub and State events. Because the selection would be done in consultation with the other State coaches the coach considered that the risk of players resenting not being selected is low.

The SA coaches consider that within Australia shooting is the weak point of all players and they intend to focus on this skill to improve the standard. He noted that to be selected for the Thai team players had to be capable of shooting to 90%.

The State Super 4 registration which was to be closed on the 25 November has been delayed until the 16 December and WA has requested that it is delayed until February. The format has also been changed to limit the second round to one female single and one mixed triple.

Tina Stockley reported that all was in place for the Expo. She and Phil had been at the site before coming to the meeting to set the stall up. She thanked Allan for the collages and Jon Giddings for providing the "how to play" poster.

9. PFA

Ray Beaumont recommended that SAPL consider purchasing the Sports software which is sold by Andre Deramond. He said it is useful to check the licence status of any player that happens along and also facilitates the implementation of the Swiss system. The committee considered that with our usual attendance of 20 teams at the league events it was not viable to purchase the software, laptop and printer necessary to use it.

The Australian Petanque Festival will be held over the Easter week with the Australian Singles, Doubles and Triples championships being held sequentially.

10. A.O.B

Adrian Clements noted that the Coonawarra club had written to say that after 20 years of running the "Coonawarra Classic" the club has decided that there was too much work involved and would not be organizing an event in 2017. Deb Rodda suggested that perhaps SAPL could offer support to Coonawarra and the Secretary was asked to write to the President and Secretary thanking them for their efforts and offering support.
